One of the airplanes to be featured at the airshow is a B-24 Liberator. This was the most manufactured aircraft of WWII.

Bruce Cook of the Historical Aircraft Squadron will be rolling out his recently purchased Stearman Bii-plane for some aerial demonstrations.

Other aircraft include Aerobatic Stearman of Cliff Robinson, O-2 in honor of our dinner speaker Mike Jackson and the flying farmer act with Greg Aldridge.

The kids will enjoy the Auto helicopter. We have also scheduled a heritage flight featuring A-10s and Brad Hood's P-51 Mustang.

The awe inspiring Mig-17 of Will Ward, will give us a look at one of the Soviet Unions lethal aircraft.

Others include: C-47, BT-13, 2 L5's, 2 L-16s, T-28 and a B-2 flyby.

THIS MONTH IN HISTORY

August 20, 1911

Lincoln Beachey set a new world altitude record of 11,642 feet at the Chicago Meet.

August 20, 1935

Leslie R. Tower and a crew of 3, flew Boeing 299 bomber (prototype of the B-17) for 2,100 miles from Seattle, Washington, to Dayton, Ohio nonstop, at average speed of 232.2 mph.

August 21, 1923

First airways illumination, when 42 landing fields in the Chicago-Iowa City-Omaha-North Platte-Cheyenne Route were lit by 18 and 86 inch electric arc beacons, visible for 50 miles.
